Town Crier Terry said: "I booked 12 tables and it was a fabulous, hectic evening with about 30 teams. I assumed the winners were known to the Crown. It wasn't until the next day when the penny dropped that nobody knew who they were."

He added: "At least their whereabouts and the location of the trophy will make a do not want to lose the trophy.

The winning team called themselves Hamilton-Hanson.

Cllr Broadhead has sent the Crown and the Town Crier a letter of congratulations. He said: "It was a terrific sum of money raised on the night."
